Letter Matching Game

Instructions:

Print & Prepare:

- Print out the alphabet matching game sheets. Use thicker paper or cardstock for durability and/or laminate for repeated use.
- Carefully cut out the boxes containing uppercase letters, lowercase letters, and corresponding pictures.

How to Play:

- Mix up the letter and picture cards, then spread them face-up on a flat surface.
 Have your child try to match an uppercase letter, a lowercase letter, and a matching picture.
- For an extra challenge, place the cards face down and try playing the game like a memory match!

Additional Ideas:

- For younger children, start with just a few letters and gradually add more as they become more confident.
- Try playing with a timer to see how many matches can be made in a set amount of time.
